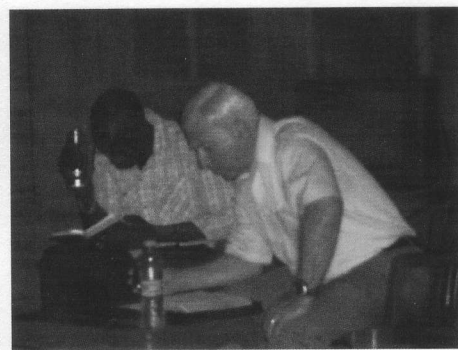

Dear Prayer Partners,

The year 2011 saw the birth of a new country called the Republic of Southern Sudan. Since my ministry is in Northern Sudan, I decided to go to Southern Sudan, start a ministry there, and eventually connect it with the northern part.

So, I went to the new country of Southern Sudan. I checked the internet to see if there were any Independent Baptist churches. I found no churches registered in the capital city. The people I asked didn't know of and had never heard of a Baptist church anywhere in the city. So, we decided to start a Baptist Church. We registered the New Testament Baptist Church with the government, and applied for a license for a radio station. Our application was approved, and we now have the license. Additionally, our ministry purchased a piece of property in the city of Juba, the capital, to be used as a local church.

Gasim and Erica will be part of our ministerial team in Sudan. Gasim is of Sudanese origin. Gasim was a Moslem young man who came to America and accepted Christ as his Savior. Later, he met his wife in the Bible college from which they both graduated. As soon as he finishes raising his support, he and his family will move to Southern Sudan in order to minister there. Gasim will be the pastor of the newly established church.

30 people saved!

I preached to a group of about 65 people who may become the nucleus for our church in Southern Sudan. About 30 people raised their hands and prayed the prayer of salvation.

One of the great blessings is that in my sermon I told the story of a former Iraqi Moslem general whom I led to Christ. After the service, 2 men came to me and told me that they used to be generals in the Southern Sudan army. They also were Moslems just like the Iraqi general and accepted Christ as their Savior. They were encouraged to know that there are generals coming to know Jesus as their Savior.

Update From Iraq!

The American military has left Iraq. It seems that this was a premature move, because, as soon as the American troops pulled out, the Prime Minister, a Shiite Muslim, sought to put the Vice-President in jail. This created great tension in the country between the Sunis and the Shiites. At the advise of Pastor Maher, I had to cancel my trip to Baghdad in January.

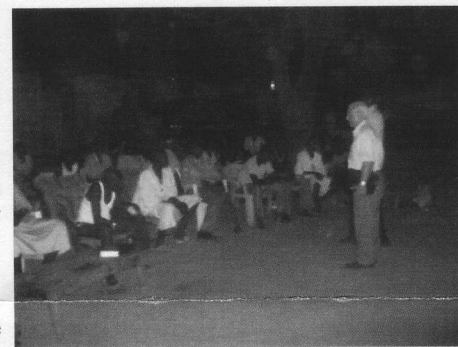
So far, our ministry in Iraq has not been affected. The Iraqi Army continues to guard our church. More and more people are tuning in to our radio station to hear the Gospel.

By the time you receive this letter, Pastor Maher of Baghdad and I will be holding a conference in Khartoum, Northern Sudan and having revival meetings. We will also be graduating 80 students from our Bible Institute. Please pray that the Lord will give us many souls for His glory, and that more people will surrender and serve the Lord.

Many Moslems and non-Moslems are putting their trust in Christ.
