B. Be at Peace

- 1. Live Peaceably**
(1 Thess. 5:13; Mk. 9:50; Acts 7:26; Rom. 12:18; 2 Cor. 13:11)
- 2. Seek Peace (Rom. 14:19; 1 Thess. 5:15; Acts 9:5)**

II. Serve (One Another)

A. Our Meekness in Serving (Gal. 5:13; John 8:33; Mk. 10:44)

Greek, *douleuo* (#1398) to serve as a slave, be a slave.

B. Our Ministry in Serving

- 1. Daily Ministry (John 13:1-17; 1 Tim. 5:10)**
Greek, *nipto* (#3538) to cleanse (hands, feet or face).
- 2. Divine Ministry (1 Pet. 4:10; Mk. 15:40-41; Acts 6:2,4;
1 Cor. 14:12; Mk. 10:45)**

Greek, *diakoneo* (#1247) to be an attendant, wait upon.
